



Coin Wars 2016!

Ladoga Elementary School is hosting a "Coin War" Monday, September 8 - Thursday, September 29th to raise money for the American Cancer Society Making Strides Walk. We are raising money to help put an end to this disease that has affected so many of our lives, as well as to honor the SM CSC employees who have lost or are continuing to fight their battle against cancer.

This year, each class will be competing against one another. The students in the class that win the Coin War Competition will each get a can of Silly String to spray Mr. Myers, Mrs. Gabbard, and their classroom teacher during an extra recess on Friday the 30th, complete with popsicles!

The rules for the Coin War are as follows:

- All COINS will be counted each day & totals will be announced the following morning's announcements.
- Each cent earned from coins will count as positive points toward the total for each class.
- All CASH (paper money) OR CHECKS placed in a competing classroom's container will deduct from that classroom's total number of points. For example: Ms. McCormick's class has 420 points (cents in coins) in her bucket, but a student from Mrs. Gott's class puts a dollar bill in Ms. McCormick's bucket. Ms. McCormick's class loses 100 points (cents) from their total, leaving them with 320 points for the day.
