MEDICATION REQUIRED DURING SCHOOL HOURS

Indiana Law IC34.4-16.5 3.5 of the Indiana Tort Claims Acts allows the school nurse or other designated school personnel to assist students who are required to take medication during the school day. This service is provided to enable the student to remain in school and maintain or improve the potential for learning.

I release and agree to hold the school district, school board, its officials and employees harmless from any and all liability for damages or injury resulting directly or indirectly from this authorization.

I give the school nurse permission to consult with the prescribing/attending physician regarding benefits and side effects of this medication.
